# Transfer of the Most Blessed Sacrament -

After the Prayer After Communion, the Priest puts incense in the thurible, blesses it and then, kneeling, incenses the Blessed Sacrament.

A procession is formed in which the Blessed Sacrament is carried through the church to a suitable place of repose. As the hymn "Pange Lingua" (hymn 169) or another eucharistic chant is sung, all follow in procession.

When the procession reaches the place of repose, the Priest enses 2 Blessed Sacrament while "Tantum Ergo Sacramentum" (hymn 16 *sr* another ss. 5eucharistic chant is sung. Then the Deacon or the Priest himsel, he Sacre nt in the tabernacle and closes the door.

The faithful are invited to continue adoration being the Blessed S. nt for a suitable length of time during the night, accordin, local circumstances, but after midnight the adoration should take place without sole.
